Two inverters, one for 240 and one for 110. Can draw shore power from either 110 or 240v. Super wind 350W wind generator with regulator, 2x 130W solar panels with regulator. Battery chargers: 30 amp and 100-amp Dolphin. Plus 55 amp alternator with separate regulator on main engine in

addition to the starting battery alternators on each of the gen set and main engine, 110volt 1800w inverter, 220 volt 1800w inverter, Isolating transformer fitted to shore power input, Shore cables for USA, NZ and Europe on board, Main house batteries are 12 x 6volt in three banks of 4 giving 24 volt system, 2 separate starting batteries for engine and genset, LED down light mizzen, LED down light main mast, Red/white LED pilot house light, 2 electric and 1 manual bilge pumps. And one portable electric. One portable manual. Float switch and warning buzzer on the main pump, Anchor wash, deck wash, Volt meters and ammeters for all systems.


**GROUND TACKLE:** 33 Kg Rocna anchor and 100m of 10mm galvanized anchor chain. Re-galvanized 2024 70m 24mm nylon warp, 25 Kg Lewmar delta anchor Re-galvanized 2024 30m 10mm galvanized anchor chain and 70m, 24mm nylon warp. 10m 10mm galvanized anchor chain for dual anchor system.

## **ANCHOR WINCH:** Lofrans Electric windlass

**SAFETY EQUIPMENT:** EPIRB, 3 Fire extinguishers 2 x 1.3 kg dry powder, 1x2 kg dry powder, Emergency tiller, portable air horn, NZ cat 1 flares (out of date), Life raft 4-man 2019 Crew saver UK ISO Ocean (GLR) Serviced 2023, exp 2026, Sea anchor with chain, swivels and 150m nylon rode.

**EXTRA CHATTELS:** Davits, Heavy duty dock lines, Fenders, Rear deck mattresses and mizzen boom tent, cockpit cushions, cockpit table. Sunbrella cockpit window covers & winch covers. Insect screens for hatches and ports. Sunshade screens for cockpit. Cockpit can be fully enclosed with bimini extension and roll up clears new Dec 2022, boom tent for mizzen boom.

TENDER/DINGHY: Yes, 3.2m Southern Pacific with 3.3hp Mercury Outboard







## ADDITIONAL NOTES OR POINTS OF INTEREST

Propeller shaft seals and bushing replaced. Oil has been changed in the C drive. Propeller, Autoprop new bearings and seals 2022. New underwater zincs. Recent general maintenance including New sunbrella hatch covers, new hatch insect screens, new sunbrella wind screen and side window covers, and new cockpit seat squabs. Engine and gearbox oil changes as scheduled. New full cockpit enclosure with roll up clears Dec 22. There are five discrete watertight compartments. A collision protection bulkhead forward of the forward cabin. The forward cabin has a rubber gasketed door making it watertight, as does the stern cabin. The engine room is central and under the cockpit and is a watertight compartment and finally the huge aft lazarette forms the fifth watertight compartment.
