The well-appointed galley is positioned to remain part of the social area, making meal preparation enjoyable whether entertaining guests or spending extended periods aboard. Abundant storage throughout the vessel ensures everything has its place for long-distance cruising.

Power comes from a pair of dependable 220 horsepower Hino diesel engines renowned for their longevity, economical operation and straightforward maintenance. Together they provide reliable cruising performance while offering the confidence demanded by serious coastal cruisers.

This vessel is exceptionally well equipped, featuring a Westerbeke generator, watermaker, Wesmar stabilisers, substantial battery capacity, inverter system and a comprehensive inventory of cruising equipment. These additions significantly enhance onboard comfort and independence, allowing extended periods away from marinas without sacrificing convenience.

The inclusion of underwater exhausts contributes to a quieter cruising experience, while the tender package further enhances the vessel's versatility when exploring secluded anchorages.

Machinery

Twin Hino 220hp diesel engines provide dependable and economical propulsion. Supported by a Westerbeke generator and extensive onboard electrical systems, the vessel is exceptionally well suited for extended independent cruising.

A significant feature of this Bayliner is the impressive inventory fitted for serious cruising. Wesmar stabilisers improve comfort underway, while the watermaker, inverter and substantial battery capacity provide outstanding self-sufficiency when spending extended periods away from shore facilities.
