Scott Robson Designed • 12.4m High-Speed Aluminium Powercat

A proven commercial workhorse today. An extraordinary private powercat tomorrow.

Designed by renowned New Zealand naval architect **Scott Robson** and purpose-built by **Metal Works Innovations, Tauranga**, *Moutohora Cat* is a substantial 12.4-metre aluminium catamaran conceived for speed, stability, efficiency and versatility.

Launched in **2006**, she has been operated as a commercial passenger vessel and surveyed for up to **48 passengers**. Her robust aluminium construction, expansive beam, shallow one-metre draft and impressive **700hp of new Yamaha power fitted in 2024** make her an exceptionally interesting proposition.

But perhaps her greatest opportunity lies in what she could become.

Strip away the commercial seating and equipment and the buyer is left with the bones of something genuinely special: **a large, fast, stable and exceptionally capable private powercat with enormous potential for a bespoke conversion.**

BUILT TO WORK. READY TO TRANSFORM.

There is a growing appreciation for large aluminium powercats among private owners who want something different from the conventional production motor yacht.

Moutohora Cat offers precisely that opportunity.

Her **4.4-metre beam**, twin-hull configuration and shallow **1-metre draft** create a remarkably stable platform, while the Scott Robson design pedigree brings a serious performance and seakeeping foundation.

Imagine replacing the existing passenger fitout with:

- A luxurious open-plan saloon
- Expansive lounge and dining areas
- Gourmet galley
- Private owner's cabin
- Guest accommodation
- Modern bathroom facilities
- Large entertaining cockpit
- Sun lounges and outdoor dining
- Fishing and diving equipment
- Tender storage
- Custom hardtop or flybridge
- Premium marine upholstery and finishes

The result could be a **one-off private cruising catamaran unlike anything else on the market.**

And importantly, the hard work has already been done: the hull exists, the structure is substantial, and the vessel is powered by **two brand-new 350hp Yamaha outboards.**

THE PERFORMANCE

With **700 horsepower** on the transom, *Moutohora Cat* is no slow-moving displacement cat.

Cruising Speed: 22 knots

Maximum Speed: 30 knots

That means genuine cruising capability — whether heading across the Hauraki Gulf, exploring the Bay of Islands, running down the coast or simply getting the family to the weekend destination quickly.

Her **1,000-litre fuel capacity**, carried in two 500-litre tanks, provides a substantial fuel reserve for extended operations.

The twin-engine configuration also provides the redundancy and manoeuvrability expected of a serious offshore vessel.

One of the standout features of *Moutohora Cat* is her propulsion package.

The engines are water-cooled, petrol-powered outboards and represent a significant investment already made by the current owner.

For a prospective private owner, this means the conversion can focus on **how you want the boat to live**, rather than immediately confronting a major propulsion upgrade.

A PLATFORM WITH POSSIBILITIES

The existing commercial configuration is surprisingly flexible.

The passenger saloon currently features **bus-style seating mounted on tracks**, allowing the seating to be moved, reconfigured or removed. There are also **three removable tables on tracks**.

This adaptability could make conversion considerably more straightforward.

For a private owner, the existing arrangement provides a blank canvas for a completely new interior concept.

The aft deck already provides additional bench seating, while the large forward area between the hulls incorporates a particularly useful feature:



A BOW LANDING RAMP

The forward bow ramp is accessed via steps between the hulls and was designed for beach landings. For a private vessel, this could become an outstanding feature for:

Beach days • Island exploring • Diving • Fishing • Water sports • Family adventures

Pull onto a remote beach, lower the ramp and walk straight ashore.

Few conventional motor yachts can offer that capability.

PRIVATE YACHT CONVERSION — THE VISION

This is where *Moutohora Cat* becomes particularly compelling.

A buyer could take the existing commercial platform and create something completely bespoke.

Imagine this...

The passenger seating removed.

The interior opened up.

Beautiful timber or modern composite flooring.

Deep, comfortable lounges.

A generous dining table.

Contemporary galley.

Luxury heads.

Private sleeping accommodation.

Opening windows and large-screen entertainment.

An aft cockpit designed around outdoor living.

And forward, that extraordinary beach-access ramp.

Outside, the 4.4-metre beam provides room to create substantial outdoor living spaces.

The finished boat could be part expedition vessel, part luxury launch, part island-hopping machine.

And because the underlying vessel was designed for commercial passenger service, she starts with a level of structural capability rarely found in a conventional pleasure craft.
